COP30 is being billed as humanity's last chance to course-correct. But summits mean nothing without real commitment — from governments, corporations, and each of us. Every ton of carbon we save, every tree we plant, every watt of renewable energy we use counts toward survival.

The Earth is not negotiating anymore. It's warning us — perhaps for the last time. If we fail to act today, tomorrow's headlines won't speak of overshoot or emissions - they'll speak of extinction.
