Afghanistan's Self-Inflicted Folly — And Pakistan's **Moment to Walk Awav**

The Taliban-led Afghan regime's asinine and un-grateful decision to suspend all trade with Pak-istan is yet another reminder that sentimentality in foreign policy is a luxury Pakistan can no longer afford. For decades, Pakistan has paid a staggering economic, social and security price for propping up Afghanistan—always under the illusion of "Islamic brotherhood." Yet Kabul's repeated backstabbing proves that Pakistan doesn't need enemies when it has meighbors like this. In the midst of its unholy honey-moon with the mad dog of South Asia, Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi, the delusional Kabul adminis-tration seems convinced it can replace Pakistan with new trade partners. If Afghanistan believes it has options, then it must also be reminded—so does Pakistan.

And perhaps this forced rupture will finally free Pak-



istan from the rampant abuse, corruption and smuggling that flourished under Afghan transit trade. The shock waves now rippling through Khyber Pakhtunkhwa's traders and transporters are understandable. Hundreds of trucks stranded at Torkham, industries reliant on Afghan coal, and fears of losing access to Central Asian markets paint a grim short-term picture. Business leaders warn of huge financial losses, shuttered factories, jobless labourers, and plummeting tax revenues. Local

traders caught between contractual obligations and a sealed border now find themselves trapped between the devil and the deep sea. But in the long term, this rupture may be the correction Pakistan desperately needed. For too long, Afghan trade has been a one-way street of concessions, blind trust and national losses. Pakistan concessions, blind trust and national losses. Pakistan cannot allow its economy—or its dignity—to remain hostage to Kabul's tantrums. This must be the moment Islamabad adopts a clear, unapologetic Pakistan First approach. If Afghanistan wishes to sever ties, let it. Pakistan's future lies in diversifying, reforming and strengthening its own economy—not subsidizing an ungrateful neighbor intoxicated by delusions and new alliances. Sometimes loss is liberation. And this might be Pakistan's chance to finally walk away.
